Funding:

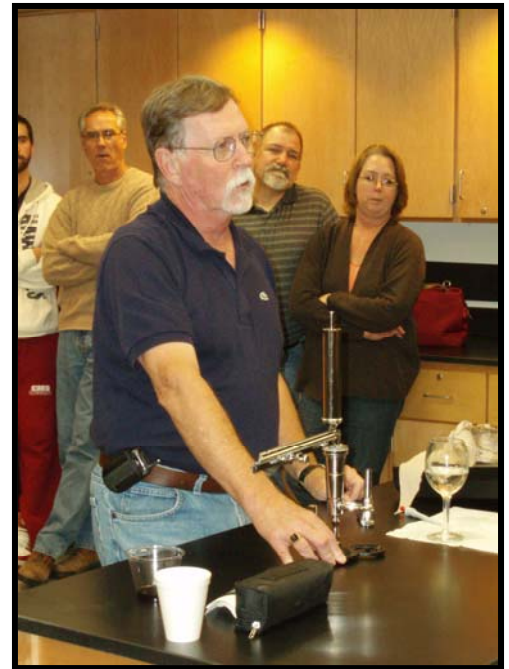
Participants: \$10,125

Day 2: Basics of red wine making and the use of tannins, laboratory demonstrations on proper use of equipment to test wine and grape juice pH, sugar, and alcohol levels.
